- WHEREAS, tribal members, Iralene (Tortice) Coombs and Joseph & Glenda (Tortice) Alderette, have requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of September 22-24, 1995; and
- WHEREAS, Michael & Cheryl (Ethelbah) Minjarez, have been chosen as Godparents and they have accepted the role; and
- WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at Fort Apache Crossing.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Iralene (Tortice) Coombs and Joseph & Glenda (Tortice) Alderette, Sponsors, and Michael & Cherly (Ethelbah) Minjarez, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of September 22-24, 1995 at Fort Apache Crossing.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 02, 1995</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (g) and (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
