RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Arizona Office of Tourism has announced that it is accepting applications for the cooperative tourism development program; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has identified in the Overall Economic Development Plan and by resolution that tourism development is a major component of the development of the economy of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the AOT cooperative program will provide up to \$25,000 for tourism promotion and advertising and that it be matched dollar for dollar.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Planning Department in conjunction with the Tribal Office of Tourism to develop and submit an application to Arizona Office of Tourism for funds for the further development and promotion of tourism on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the required match of \$25,000 be committed for the tourism promotion program.

The foregoing resolution was on March 08, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (j), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
