RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that Mr. Michael Kane and Mrs. Josephina (Thomas) Kane are requesting enrollment for their adopted son, Dominique Jordan Kane, DOB 03-31-1991, with the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that the Tribal Enrollment Committee completely reviewed Dominique Jordan Kane's enrollment application and supporting documents thereto; and
- WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee found Dominique Jordan Kane eligible for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe and that he possesses the necessary blood quantum of 1/2 White Mountain Apache blood through descendancy which exceeds Tribal Constitutional requirements for Tribal membership.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that based on the recommendation of the Tribal Enrollment Committee it hereby grants Mr. & Mrs. Michael Kane's request for enrollment of their adopted son, Dominique Jordan Kane as a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on March 08, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article II, Section 1 and 2, and Article IV, Section 1 (0), (p) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
