RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribe presently provides \$1,500.00 to assist Tribal members in funeral expenses and for the purchase of beef from the I.D. Herd to assist grieving families for funeral preparations; and

WHEREAS, it has been recommended to the Tribal Council that the funeral stipend should be increased by \$300.00 to \$1,800.00 so that families can purchase already butchered and packaged beef for funeral ceremonies as the Tribal herd is insufficient to meet these needs; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in this recommendation.

BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby increases the funeral cost stipend from \$1,500.00 to \$1,800.00 so that grieving families may purchase packaged beef for funeral ceremonies during their time of grieving.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>March 24, 1995</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
