RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the Fair and Rodeo Committee has requested that the old liquor store building be turned over to the Fair and Rodeo Committee for its permanent offices; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that the Fair and Rodeo Committee should have a permanent place to conduct business and that the old liquor store would provide adequate office space.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that the old liquor store building be turned over to the Fair and Rodeo Committee as its permanent office space.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the rental fee for use of the old liquor store building by the Fair and Rodeo Committee shall be and is hereby waived.

The foregoing resolution was on March 01, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
