RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member, Delphine Burnette, who is presently living at House #223 Spruce Street, McNary Arizona, has come before the Tribal Council and requested that the house be turned over to her; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Burnette is advised by the Tribal Council that previous requests for houses have been granted at McNary with the understanding that the land underneath the house remains with the Tribe and that no land assignments are being granted for the houses due to future plans for development of the area; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Burnette acknowledges that information from the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Delphine Burnette should be given the house located at 223 Spruce Street and that the entire responsibility for maintenance and repairs shall be hers and that the house should be taken off the McNary Housing Authority rental unit list.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby donates the house located at 223 Spruce Street in McNary to Delphine Burnette as her personal property, and should be taken off the McNary Housing Authority rental unit list.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs that no land assignment be made for the land upon which the house presently stand until further notice by the Tribal Council as land comprising the McNary townsite and land adjacent thereto have been designated as a development area.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>March 08, 1995</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
