RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe wishes to submit an application for a grant to fund certain eligible Indian Tribes and Alaskan Native Villages Community Development Block Grant Program activities and in connection with such application resolve and make certain assurances.

BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that prior to the submission of the application, the Tribal Council has:

Provided residents, especially those living in areas where activities are proposed or ongoing, with adequate information concerning the amount of funds available for proposed community development and housing activities, the range of activities that may be assisted, and other important program requirements, and solicited their views and participation.

Held at least one adequately publicized meeting at a time and location convenient to residents to obtain the views of residents on community development and housing needs.

Developed and published or posted a community development statement in such a manner as to afford affected residents an opportunity to examine its contents and to submit comments.

Considered any comments or views expressed by residents for review and comments.

Given residents an opportunity to review and comment on the applicant's performance under any active Indian community development block grant.

The foregoing resolution was on April 19, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (j), (k), (m), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
