RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Kathy Stuard from Tribal Social Services has come before the Tribal Council this date with a request that a proposed service contract between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Arizona Training and Evaluation Center, Inc. (AZTEC) be approved in the form and content attached and incorporated by reference herein; and
- WHEREAS, the purpose of the contract is to secure AZTEC's non-exclusive services to provide individuals authorized and referred by the Tribe with residential and day program service as defined in the service contract; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, having reviewed same, concludes that the Tribal Chairman should be authorized to enter into the service contract on behalf of Tribal Social Services.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Tribal Chairman Ronnie Lupe to enter into the service contract between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Arizona Training and Evaluation Center, Inc. in accordance with contract terms attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference herein.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 20, 1995</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
