RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Headstart Program received notification of a refunding application for 1995-1996; and
- WHEREAS, the funds available will assist 252 children; and
- WHEREAS, the categories under the grant include education, social services, health, nutrition, parent involvement and children with disabilities; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe concludes that it would be in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to authorize submission of a new grant application in an amount not to exceed \$1,083,815 to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services; and
- WHEREAS, the in-kind support from the White Mountain Apache Tribe will be approximately \$198,278 in Indirect Cost contributions, plus \$45,556 from State resources, for a total in-kind amount of \$243,834; and
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves submission of a refunding grant application in the amount not to exceed \$1,083,815 to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Administration of Children and Families, and commits a twenty percent (20%) match of tribal contribution, through the donation of in-kind, building maintenance, remodeling and volunteers.

The foregoing resolution was on October 11, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h) and (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
