## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member, Charles Michael White Eagle, whose birthdate is May 07, 1963, son of Charles Winston White Eagle and Loretta Way, has requested that his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that he may become eligible for enrollment in the Winnebago Tribe of Wisconsin; and
- WHEREAS, the necessary documents of relinquishment of headrights were read and signed by Charles Michael White Eagle in the presence of a Notary Public on the 14th day of September, 1995, and are attached hereto.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the Tribal membership relinquishment request of Charles Michael White Eagle, and his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe is granted relinquished this date.

The foregoing resolution was on October 12, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article II Section 3, including, Article IV, Section 1 (i), (q), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
