## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Alcohol and Drug Abuse are one of the major factors contributing to the loss of the Apache family and clan; and
- WHEREAS, the Prayer for Light Task Force was formed in 1993 to sponsor activities and prayers that promote love, healing and unity among the Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the theme for this year is "Healing the Apache Family"; and
- WHEREAS, the Prayer for Light Task Force is asking that December 3rd and 6th, 1995 be acknowledged as Prayer for Light days; and
- WHEREAS, December 3, 1995 is to be set aside as a Reservation Prayer Day, and December 6, 1995 as Prayer for Light day which includes activities and a Prayer Walk that are scheduled to begin at 3:30 p.m.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Apache Enterprise General Manager to keep the Whiteriver liquor store closed on December 3rd and December 6th, 1995 to honor the "Prayer For Light" activities.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that permission is granted to the Tribal Supervisors to allow employees administrative leave beginning at 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. to attend the Prayer for Light activities on December 6, 1995.

The foregoing resolution was on November 09, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
