RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, each member of the Tribal Council is given a regularly scheduled opportunity to speak to the public on KNNB Radio; and
- WHEREAS, a Tribal Council Election will be conducted in the late winter and spring of 1996; and
- WHEREAS, in the interest of fairness to candidates who are challenging incumbents, it has been the customary policy for the Tribal Council to suspend the Council Member radio reports during the election period; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes that this policy should apply to all members of the Tribal Council, whether or not they stand for re-election in the upcoming Tribal Elections.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that all regularly scheduled Tribal Council Reports heard on KNNB Radio Station are be canceled, effective immediately, until the close of the upcoming Tribal Elections, and that they shall be reinstated after the Tribal Elections are completed.

The foregoing resolution was on November 21, 1995, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
