RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal Member Scott Tenijieth advises the Tribal Council that he is negotiating for the purchase of Hondah Homesite A-74; and
- WHEREAS, by previous resolution he was authorized by the Tribal Council to do so; and
- WHEREAS, he comes now before the Tribal Council with a request for a ninety (90) day extension in which to negotiate the purchase price; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that there is good cause to grant the extension.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants a ninety (90) day extension to Scott Tenijieth to negotiate the purchase of Hondah Homesite A-74.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 6, 1995</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (m), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
