RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Nellie Cody, daughter of the late Ruth Dahkoshay, has come before the Tribal Council with a request that she be assigned the HIP House that was recently completed and assigned to her mother; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that Nellie Cody has a family and is presently taking care of other homeless family members and is in need of a home; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that there are compelling reasons to assign the HIP House of the late Ruth Dahkoshay to her daughter, Nellie Cody.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby assigns the late Ruth Dahkoshay's HIP House to her daughter, Nellie Cody.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 6, 1995</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
