RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has adopted an Arizona Willow Management Plan; and
- WHEREAS, said Plan has been reviewed by the Endangered Species Act Task Force Committee and has been approved thereby; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Game and Fish Department's Sensitive Species Coordinator recommends to the Tribal Council that the Arizona Willow Management Plan of the White Mountain Apache Tribe be approved, subject to final legal review and acceptance by the Tribal Chairman prior to distribution of said Plan; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with the recommendation.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts the Arizona Willow Management Plan presented by the Tribal Sensitive Species Coordinator, subject to final legal review and Tribal Chairman acceptance of same.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that distribution of the Arizona Willow Management Plan is subject to such restrictions as the Tribal Chairman's Office may impose.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 6, 1995</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (i), (m), (q), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
