RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Primary and General Tribal Elections will be held in the Spring of 1996; and
- WHEREAS, communities in each of the voting districts have public buildings which are used as polling places; and
- WHEREAS, some of the polling places are not regularly used and are in need of cleaning, renovation and utilities, such as heat, water, and electricity in order to be suitable for a polling place; and
- WHEREAS, this work must be undertaken immediately in order to prepare for the upcoming elections; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Election Commission is in the best position to determine the extent of improvements which are needed at each polling place.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Election Commission to survey the polling places and determine the repairs and other improvements which will be needed prior to the 1996 elections.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that the Election Commission shall carry out the renovations and improvements following the establishment of a budget to pay for these activities

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 20, 1995</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>one</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (k), (v), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
