

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


- WHEREAS,** The Tribal Council has been advised by Assistant Vice President E. Jane Sims, that the First Interstate Bank of Arizona, N.A. serves as Trustee of a trust created by the late Della Lucille Hazelton; and
- WHEREAS,** Said Trust provides that the annual Trust income be used for the educational needs of Arizona and Montana Indians; and
- WHEREAS,** The Trust has limited payment to two Tribes from each State per year; and
- WHEREAS,** Student members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe are eligible for this year's awards and funds will be paid in January 1996 to recipients the Tribal Council selects; and
- WHEREAS,** Recipients must be limited to high school or college students living away from home; and
- WHEREAS,** The total funds available to students on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation will be approximately \$2,600.00; and
- WHEREAS,** The Tribal Council, with the assistance of the Tribal Education Department, has compiled a list of 15 students to receive \$200.00 each and said list as well as the letter from the First Interstate Bank Trustee inviting the Tribe to compile such a list is attached to this Resolution and incorporated by reference herein; and
- WHEREAS,** The Tribal Council has reviewed the list and is agreeable therewith and wishes to approve ther persons on said list to receive the trust funds.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby expresses its appreciation to the family of the late Della Lucille Hazelton for selecting members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to be beneficiaries of some of the trust funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby approves the list of Tribal Member students attached to this Resolution and incorporated by reference herein to receive \$200.00 each from the Della Lucille Hazelton Trust No. 090039300.

The foregoing resolution was on January 23, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1(a), (l), (j), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Dear Mr. Lupe:

First Interstate Bank of Arizona, N.A., serves as trustee of a trust created by the late Della Lucille Hazelton. The trust provides that the annual income be used for the educational needs of Arizona and Montana Indians. Due to the limited size of the trust and the income earned annually we have limited the payment to two tribes from each state per year.

This is to advise you that student members of your tribe are eligible for this year's awards. Funds will be paid in January, 1996, to those recipients your council selects. Recipients should be limited to high school or college students living away from home.

Please provide us with a list of students you have chosen to receive this gift no later than January 10, 1996. The list should include the students name, address, social security number and the amount you determine is appropriate for each student. Checks will be issued to the student but forwarded to the tribal council for disbursement to the student. We estimate the total funds available to your students will be \$2,600.00. I look forward to receiving your student selections prior to January 10.
