

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council established the Tribal Labor Code to promote and preserve the interests of employees working within the Reservation; and

WHEREAS, according to the Tribal Labor Code, the Tribal Employment Rights Office (TERO) is empowered under Section 1.5.A.6. to take such actions as are necessary to achieve the purposes of the TERO chapter; and

WHEREAS, payment of wages to construction workers within the Reservation is a key component of any employee in construction-related work; and

WHEREAS, the TERO Director has recommended to the Tribal Council that a schedule of wages for specified construction activities be adopted as the prevailing wage for employment in those activities.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the schedule of wages for construction activities attached herein as a duly enacted regulation of the Tribal Employment Rights Office, with application to all construction employers and employees within the boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby delegates authority to the Tribal Chairman to enact by Executive Order a wage classification for additional construction trades and occupations which are not classified in the attached schedule, following a survey of wages by the TERO Department.

The foregoing resolution was on February 14, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
