RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tuesday, April 30, 1996 has been designated as Launch Day for Healthy Nations N'dee Benadesh; and
- WHEREAS, the purpose of the day is to promote the Healthy Nations goal of reducing alcohol and substance abuse within our Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, it is vital to the Launch Day goals that a broad spectrum of the community participates in the kick-off ceremonies to show support for the Launch Day goals and send a strong and positive message concerning the Launch Day goals to all community members.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it fully supports the Launch Day activities of the Healthy Nations N'dee Benadesh Program.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it approves two hours administrative leave for each Tribal employee who wishes to attend the Launch Day activities.

The foregoing resolution was on April 10,1996 duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (i), (s), (t), (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
