FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS.** the Tribal Council is advised that Tribal Member Michael Truesdell has become the first member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to receive his medical degree; and

**WHEREAS.** Mr. Truesdell has successfully graduated with an M.D. from the University of Arizona Medical Center; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Chairman wishes to present a plaque commemorating Mr. Truesdell's achievement and the Tribal Council concurs and joins in with congratulations to Dr. Truesdell for his personal achievement.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby congratulates Dr. Michael Truesdell as the first Tribal Member to receive a medical degree.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that it joins in with Tribal Chairman Ronnie Lupe in the presentation of commemorative plaque to Dr. Michael Truesdell for his personal achievement and for the respect and honor which he has thereby bestowed upon the White Mountain Apache Tribe.


The foregoing resolution was on May 08, 1996 duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat 984).
