

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council in Resolution No. 04-96-176, on April 10, 1996, granted permission on a trial basis to Tribal member Theresa Warrick and her husband, Vincent Warrick, to operate a towing service on the Reservation and to provide minor automobile repairs at their residence in the North Fork area; and

WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Warrick have returned to the Tribal Council to request a renewal of their permit; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has discussed the business operation with the Warricks and is satisfied that the business is operating in compliance with the permit conditions.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby permits Tribal member Theresa Warrick and her husband, Vincent Warrick, to provide towing services within the Reservation, subject to the following conditions:

1. the duration of the permit shall extend for one (1) year;
2. the tow truck shall at all times during the term of the permit have in place a policy of comprehensive liability insurance for the towing operations;
3. the truck shall at all times during the term of the permit be licensed by the State of Arizona pursuant to A.R.S. Title 28, in order to operate the tow truck on state roads and right-of-ways;
4. the Warricks shall not be permitted to remove any vehicle from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, except with the prior written consent of the vehicle's owner.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Warricks are also permitted to provide minor automobile repair services at the location of their residence at North Fork, provided that no more than four (4) vehicles are on the premises at one time for repairs, and that the operation does not disturb any of the neighbors in the vicinity.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in addition to the foregoing conditions, the automobile towing and repair business must comply with Tribal law and all other conditions and regulations as may be enforced by the Tribal Treasurer's Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the permission granted under this Resolution is revocable at any time, for any reason, at the discretion of the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on June 05, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (t), (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
