**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, representatives of the Baptist Church have come before the Tribal Council this date with the request that a Revival sponsored by the church to be held in the Diamond Creek area be recognized and sanctioned by the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to grant approval for the Baptist Church Revival to be held in the Diamond Creek area.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and recognizes the Baptist Church Revival to be held in the Diamond Creek area June 23 - 28, 1996.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs the sponsors and participants of the Revival to check with BIA Forestry and obey all fire restrictions in place during the time of the Revival and to otherwise protect the environment in that area.

The foregoing resolution was on June 5, 1996 duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section I (a), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
