**WHEREAS**, Mr. Henry will be seeking contracts throughout the Reservation for yard work and tilling services; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council is in support of Mr. Henry's entrepreneurship and wishes him well with his new business endeavor.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby recognizes, approves and encourages tribal member Darrell Henry's entrepreneurship and wishes him business success in his new business known as "Henry's Tilling Services."

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1996 duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section I (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
