

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has established the Tribal Office of Tourism as an important priority and has accepted funds for the development of et Office with specific goals and objectives; and


WHEREAS, The Tribal Office of Tourism has reached a goal and accomplished an objective by the completion of a Strategic Tourism Plan in accordance with funding requirements; and

WHEREAS, The Strategic Tourism Plan has been reviewed and approved by the OEDP Committee of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council of the Whit Mountain Apache Tribe concurs with the the final adoption of the Strategic Tourism Plan.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Strategic Tourism Plan is hereby officially adopted and the Director of the Tribal Office of Tourism is hereby directed to implement the plan.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
