

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS**, the Budget Committee has the responsibility to review all proposed budgets for the fiscal year and make recommendations to the Tribal Council for their consideration and adoption permitting tribal organizations to operate on a budget for the year; and
- WHEREAS**, the previous fiscal year ended on April 30, 1993 and the Tribe is currently operating on a Continuing Resolution; and
- WHEREAS**, the Budget Committee has divided its work into consideration of first Central Tribe Budget and secondly Enterprise Budgets; and
- WHEREAS**, the Budget Committee has to be date reviewed and examined the proposed budgets for Central Tribe and will later report to and recommend budgets for Enterprises; and
- WHEREAS**, the Budget Committee's first consideration was to examine the fiscal position of the Tribe as of April 20, 1996 and to make decisions concerning the likely available revenues for FY 96/97 and to review all proposed budgets within that context with the aim of achieving a balanced budget; and
- WHEREAS**, the Report and Recommendations of the Budget Committee for Central Tribe for Fiscal Year 96/97 and the recommended budgets for Central Tribe are enclosed showing projected revenues of \$15,151,202 and expenses of \$15,110,769 (that includes capital expenditures of \$474,820), resulting in a surplus of \$40,433 and are hereby made part of this Resolution.
- BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Report and Recommendations of the Budget Committee for Central Tribe for Fiscal Year 96/97 and the Central Tribe budget with revenues of \$15,151,202 and expenditures of \$15,110,769 be adopted and immediately implemented.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that any and all previously adopted Resolutions in conflict with this Resolution, the Report and Recommendations of the Budget Committee incorporated by reference, and the financial pages that accompany the Report be rescinded immediately.

The foregoing resolution was on July 16, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1(a), (i), (j), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
