

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** Tribal Member Kino Kane has come before the Tribal Council this date requesting assistance for his grandson, Quintin Lee, who on September 16, 1991 suffered third degree burns over 40% of his body; and

**WHEREAS,** Mr. Kane explains to the Council that he seeks assistance so that his grandson can attend a burn camp in Prescott, Arizona, during the week of August 11 through the 18th; and

**WHEREAS,** The cost of the camp and transportation will be approximately \$900.00 and Chairman Ronnie Lupe offers to pay for the camp through the Chairman's Public Relationship Fund and the Tribal Council concurs,

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Tribal Member Kino Kane to fund his grandson, Quintin Lee, attendance at a burn camp in Prescott, Arizona August 11 through August 18, 1996.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the \$900.00 funding assistance shall be funded from the Chairman's Public Relations Fund.

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1(a), (i), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
