

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** Susie Tenijieth, Manager of the Tribal Fair & Rodeo, has come before the Tribal Council and presented the Tribal Fair & Rodeo report and requests that the Tribal Council authorize \$20,000.00 from tribal funds to pay for a stock contract with Casper Baca; and


**WHEREAS,** the 3-year stock contract with Casper Baca expires 1998 and the stock fee this year is \$20,000.00; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council is advised and acknowledges that the quality of Casper Baca rodeo stock is foremost in the rodeo circuit and that the success of the tribal rodeo is dependent upon obtaining stock that is respected and desired by rodeo participants.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby amends the Fair & Rodeo budget and authorizes the expenditure of \$20,000.00 in Tribal funds for the use and purchase of stock from Casper Baca for this year's Tribal Fair & Rodeo.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes and directs the Tribal Chairman or his designee and the Tribal Treasurer to expend \$20,000.00 in Tribal Funds for the purpose of this resolution and that the Tribal Treasurer amend the Fair & Rodeo budget to reflect same.

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
