

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has adopted the Central Tribe Budget for FY 96/97; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Police Department has appeared before the Tribal Council with a request for \$260,000 for security and parking for the Annual Tribal Fair and Rodeo; and

WHEREAS, the Fair and Rodeo Committee has appeared before the Tribal Council requesting an additional \$20,000 for the stock contract; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is concerned with the security and safety of visitors and tribal members attending the Tribal Fair and Rodeo, but notes that the initial budget request from the Police Department was for \$80,000 and that the budget adopted for the Fair and Rodeo Commission includes sufficient funding for the Annual Fair, provided the sponsors and contributions are included and the staff is budgeted for six months rather than yearly with few or no defined duties after the end of October.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the amendment of the Tribal Budget to add \$80,000 to the Police Department for the sole purpose of providing security and safety for the Fair, provided that Tribal Police Department employees already on salary will not be paid again.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Fair and Rodeo Commission use the funds already appropriated to be used for the Annual Fair and that employees understand that their positions are to terminate at the end of October each year.


The foregoing resolution was on August 09, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribe Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (j), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
