- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further wishes to express its appreciation to the late Fred Larzelere, Sr. for the public service he performed as Tribal Chairman and Councilmember of the White Mountain Apache Tribe by assuming the funeral and burial expenses for the late Fred Larzelere, Sr.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby expresses its respect and appreciation to the public service performed by the late Fred Larzelere, Sr. when he was Tribal Chairman and Councilmember of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Chairman, and in his absence the Vice-Chairman, to appropriate tribal funds for the payment of the funeral and burial expenses for the late Fred Larzelere, Sr.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 4, 1996</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
