

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to express its sympathy to Mrs. Charlie Lane and the family of Charlie Lane to mark the occasion of his passing away from this earthly existence; and

WHEREAS, Charlie Lane, formerly a Captain with the Navajo County Sheriff's Office while an active member of the County Sheriff's Department, provided the Tribal Council, Police Department and the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe with law enforcement assistance, search and rescue assistance and acted as a liaison between the tribe and off-reservation law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, Charlie Lane respected the sovereignty, jurisdiction, culture and people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and was a defender of the Tribe's territory; and

WHEREAS, after Charlie Lane's retirement from Navajo County Sheriff's Office, he continued to volunteer his services as a special commissioned tribal police officer to assist the Tribal Police at inaugural activities and the Tribal Fair and Rodeo and whenever volunteer law enforcement assistance was requested or necessary; and

WHEREAS, even at the age of 75 years, Charlie Lane volunteered his services at the recent annual Tribal Fair and Rodeo; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to express its appreciation and deepest sympathies for the family of Charlie Lane.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby expresses its appreciation for Captain Charlie Lane for his long lifetime services and assistance to the White Mountain Apache Tribe in the area of public safety and protection.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it further expresses its appreciation for Charlie Lane's long time respect and advocacy for tribal jurisdiction and sovereignty which has contributed immeasurably to the fine working relationship the Tribe has with the Navajo County Sheriff's Office to this day.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it expresses its deepest sympathies and condolences to Mrs. Charlie Lane and members of the Lane family for the loss of their beloved Charlie Lane.

The foregoing resolution was on September 04, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
