


**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


- WHEREAS,** the Bureau of Indian Affairs has acquired two TEOM, Ambient Particulate PM-10 Monitors for smoke generated by prescribed burning; and
- WHEREAS,** the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Branch of Forestry would like to place one of these units in the town of Cibecue; and
- WHEREAS,** the best sites for placement would be either the Tribal Land Operations Yard or the Fire Station; and
- WHEREAS,** the requirements for installation are: 4x4 cement slab, power and a phone line; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Forestry Department will have unlimited access to all data generated by the unit as well as all maintenance information deemed necessary by the Resource Monitor to ensure accuracy of the data collected; and
- WHEREAS,** the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Branch of Forestry will bear the cost of installation and operation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission for the Bureau of Indian Affairs to place a TEOM unit at either one of these sites.

The foregoing resolution was on September 12, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Sections 1 (a), (f), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
