

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, officers of the Canyon Day Livestock Association have come before the Tribal Council with a request that the Tribal Council approve its proposed range and grazing plan for said association; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, having reviewed the range and grazing plan, concludes that the plan should be approved; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the Articles of Incorporation and Reorganization of the Canyon Day Livestock Association have not been completed to date.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the range and grazing plan for the Canyon Day Livestock Association in the form attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it urges the Canyon Day Livestock Association to adopt and revise Articles of Incorporation, have a vote of its membership in respect to said Articles, and present them as soon as possible to the Tribal Council for approval so that it will become eligible for the \$10,000.00 in tribal assistance authorized by previous council resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on October 02, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (h), (i), (k), (q), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
