RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, representatives of the Cedar Creek Livestock Association have come before the Tribal Council this date for approval of its proposed range and grazing plan; and
- WHEREAS, the Cedar Creek Livestock Association had previously submitted its revised Articles of Incorporation, which were approved by the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the range and grazing plan for the Cedar Creek Livestock Association, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution and incorporated by reference herein, and the Tribal Council concludes that said plan should be approved.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the range and grazing plan for the Cedar Creek Livestock Association in the form and content attached and incorporated by reference herein.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the release of \$10,000.00 to the Cedar Creek Livestock Association, if said sum has not already been previously released by prior resolution, the Cedar Creek Livestock Association having submitted revised and approved Articles of Incorporation and a range and grazing plan for the Association.

The foregoing resolution was on October 02, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (h), (I), (k), (m), (q), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
