

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS,** Alcohol and Drug Abuse are one of the major factors contributing to the loss of the Apache family and clan; and
- WHEREAS,** the Prayer for Light Task Force was formed in 1993 to sponsor activities and prayers that promote love, healing and unity among the Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the theme for this year is "BRINGING TO LIGHT THE TRUTH OF OUR ADDICTIONS"; and
- WHEREAS,** the Prayer for Light Task Force is asking that December 1 and 5, 1996 be acknowledged as Prayer for Light days; and
- WHEREAS,** December 1, 1996 to be set aside as a Reservation Prayer Day, and December 5, 1996 as Prayer For Light day which includes activities scheduled to begin at 1:30 p.m.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Apache Enterprise General Manager to keep the Whiteriver liquor store closed on December 1st and December 5th, 1996 to honor the "Prayer For Light" activities.




