

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe wishes to renew its membership in the National Congress of American Indians; and

WHEREAS, membership requires that annual dues be paid; and

WHEREAS, as part of the privilege of membership, the Tribe has the opportunity to vote at NCAI meetings, such voting to be cast by the authorized tribal delegate or alternate.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that renewal of membership in NCAI be authorized and the dues paid from the Chairman's budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman Ronnie Lupe be designated as the voting delegate and that Vice-Chairman Lafe Altaha, Councilman Herbert Tate and Councilwoman Margaret Baha-Walker be designated as alternates.
