RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by Resolution No. 09-96-220 directed the Tribal Council Secretary to post proposed amendments to the Health and Safety Code, Chapter 11, to amend the tribal liquor laws to be consistent with newly revised state liquor laws and to provide for mandatory penalties for bootlegging violations on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in each district for a minimum of 10 days as required by the constitution; and
- WHEREAS, the Council Secretary advises the Tribal Council that said proposed ordinance has been posted in accordance with that directive; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council having received no opposition to the proposed amendments to the Health and Safety Code concludes that Ordinance No.206 amending the tribal liquor laws in conformity with state liquor laws and providing for mandatory tribal penalties for bootlegging violations on the Reservation should be enacted; and
- WHEREAS, it is necessary to do a walk-through resolution for final approval of Ordinance No. 206 in order to enact the liquor law amendments prior to election day on November 5, 1996 to enable the Hondah Casino and other tribal outlets to serve liquor on election day.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts Ordinance No. 206 amending the Chapter 11 of the Health and Safety Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in the form attached and incorporated by reference herein.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the acts and deeds of the members of the Tribal Council necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Resolution be, and the same are hereby ratified, confirmed and adopted as the acts and deeds of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on October 17, 1996, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i) (q), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Signatures of the members of the Tribal Council represent their approval of Tribal Resolution No. <u>10-96-266</u>.
