RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal Member Rovene Nosie has come before the Tribal Council to describe his intentions to go into business providing heating and cooling repair services; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Nosie presented his credentials indicating training and education in refrigeration, electrical principals, residential air conditioning, and residential and commercial electrical applications; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Nosie has requested recognition by the Tribal Council of his new business to be known as Seven Mile Heating and Cooling; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes the value and importance of private enterprise within the Reservation by Tribal Members.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby recognizes Seven Mile Heating and Cooling operated by Rovene Nosie as a heating and cooling business operating within the Reservation, subject to the White Mountain Apache Tribe Law and Order Code.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 16, 1996</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Sections 1(a), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
