## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS,

the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe passed Resolution No. 12-90-274 which created a tribal solid waste committee to address the problem of trash burning, open dumping and, in general, lack of adequate solid waste management facilities; and

WHEREAS.

the solid waste committee and other efforts have been successful in dealing with the issue of solid waste and today the Tribe operates a reservation-wide residential trash collection service, manages its own landfill built to federal standards, continues to clean up old backwoods and community dumpsites and is implementing its own solid waste regulatory program; and

WHEREAS,

a Tribal Solid Waste Board was established by Resolution No. 02-96-045 to oversee the activities of the Tribal Solid Waste Authority, now the Tribal Public Works Department, and to continue to involve tribal enterprise, department and community leaders in the tribal solid waste program; and

WHEREAS,

the further operation of the tribal solid waste committee is no longer needed and the disbandment/discontinuation of the committee was approved by the Tribal Plan and Project Review panel at its December 1996 meeting.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it approves the disbandment/discontinuation of the tribal solid waste committee as the purpose for which it was created has been served and is no longer needed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Environmental Planner will notify solid waste committee members of this action.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 16, 1996</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Sections 1 (f), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
