BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that each sponsor read, sign, and abide by the Waste Disposal Requirements for Camps attached to this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 8, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (g), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 19933, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

PROPER WASTE DISPOSAL FOR CAMPS

Sunrise Dance camps and Church gatherings need a waste disposal system for trash and debris generated for the duration of the camp. When these spiritual happenings are over, there is trash scattered throughout the sites and in the streams. With the proper assistance from Tribal Departments, We can help keep these areas beautiful.

Trash and debris attract insects and animals which might carry diseases and possibly contaminate the water and foodstuff. For this problem, waste disposal companies will deposit a dumpster at the campsite for a minimum fee. This will assist in trash elimination.

Vegetation and construction debris used as shade and fencing will be disposed of by Tribal Departments. The Solid Waste Department and Community Service Program will haul vegetation and structural debris for a small charge.

These requirements are subject to White Mountain Apache Tribe Solid Waste Ordinance (October 1995) with its attendant guidelines and penalties. This will help encourage People to respect and keep our land clean.
