RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is a member of the Inter-Tribal Transportation Association; and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Council approval to pay membership dues of \$100 to the Inter-Tribal Transportation Association is requested; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that it would be in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for the Tribe to maintain its membership in the Inter-Tribal Transportation Association and to pay the \$100 membership dues.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves expenditure of \$100 in tribal funds to pay for membership dues in the Inter-Tribal Transportation Association.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 5, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribe Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
