RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, by prior resolution, the Fair and Rodeo Office was directed to close after the annual Tribal Fair and Rodeo; and
- WHEREAS, the Fair and Rodeo Office has on-going duties, such as monitoring vendors and use of the exhibit hall, and the Tribal Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the Tribe if the Fair and Rodeo Office operate full time due to the foregoing and other year round responsibilities.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorize and approves and directs that the Tribal Fair and Rodeo Office operate full time on an annual budget year basis, the same as other tribal departments and enterprises, due to its year round responsibilities as described herein.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 6, 1997</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Sections 1 (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
