RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal Member Moyer Lee has come before the Tribal Council this date and requested that the Tribal Council approve a 200' x 200' land assignment behind the Indian Health Service compound; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Lee explains that he has not yet appeared before the Tribal Land Board, although he did file an application, but that he is faced with an emergency because it is urgent that he has a place for his newly purchased mobile home, which is to be delivered immediately; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that he should be granted his request, but that he should then advise the Tribal Land Board of the Council's action; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council does not wish to set a precedent, but that the special circumstances of Mr. Moyer Lee's particular case indicate an emergency, and that the Land Board will not meet soon enough to accommodate the emergency.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes a 200' x 200' homesite assignment behind the Indian Health Service compound for tribal member Moyer Lee's mobile home.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs Mr. Lee and the Tribal Council Secretary to notify the Tribal Land Board of the Council's action this date.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby gives public notice that this resolution is an exception and not a precedent and that the usual homesite procedure is for the Land Board to first approve the land/homesite assignment application prior to coming before the Tribal Council, but that the emergency circumstances of this particular case has dictated that the Tribal Council act prior to the Land Board Meeting approving Mr. Moyer Lee's application.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>March 13, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribe Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1(a), (i), (m), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
