- WHEREAS, Doris Hinton of Apache Behavioral Health Services Job Functions and Karen Fall of the White Mountain Apache Police Job Functions has come before the Tribal Council this date with the request that the Tribal Council recognize "Victims Rights Week" commencing Monday, April 14, 1997 through April 18, 1997; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is requested to grant permission for tribal employees to be excused from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Monday, April 14, 1997, for a Victims Rights Walk from Bashas' Supermarket to Memorial Hall; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to support Victims Rights Week and the Victims Rights Walk to take place on April 14, 1997.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby recognizes National Victims Rights Week, April 14 18, 1997.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that it hereby approves tribal employees being excused from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., on April 14, 1997, for a Victims Rights Walk from Bashas' Supermarket to Memorial Hall.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>March 13, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribe Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
