RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Head Start Program provides Head Start services for 272 four-year old children and their families on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Head Start Program annually sponsors a "Head Start Week" that highlights several activities dedicated to the children on our reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Head Start Program, in conjunction with the Fort Apache Historic Park, is planning "Chaghashe Day Activities" on Friday, April 4, 1997, with a "Pride of Our Future" Parade, traditional dances, songs, games and activities for the entire family.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves, supports, and encourages all Tribal programs to participate in the Child Abuse Prevention Walk on April 1st, the Head Start Pow Wow on April 3rd, and Chaghashe Day Parade, and Activities on April 4th. The Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe declares April 4th as "Chaghashe Day".

The foregoing resolution was on March 14, 1997, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Sections 1 (a), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
