RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Member Rubert Lupe requests Tribal Council approval to conduct a riding school on his own land to teach rodeo events, horseback riding, roping, and basic horsemanship; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approves of his request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby recognizes and approves Tribal Member Rubert Lupe conducting a horsemanship school on his own land to teach rodeo events, horseback riding, roping, and other activities related to horsemanship.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 2, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribe Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
