

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Tribal Member Kino Kane has come before the Tribal Council this date with the complaint that he has applied for several jobs with the Tribal Health Authority but he has not received the courtesy of a response from the Health Authority as to the status of his application or its rejection; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Kane advises the Council that he has applied in good faith and is owed the courtesy of a response as to whether he was selected or not, and further advises the Council he was never even interviewed for the position by the Health Authority; and

WHEREAS, he believes he is owed an apology and that the Tribal Council should instruct tribal departments to notify applicants, who have in good faith taken the time and effort to apply for positions, of the status of their application; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council considers Mr. Kane's observations.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby advises the Tribal Health Authority and other tribal departments that applicants for tribal positions should be given the courtesy of an interview and/or a reply letter as to the disposition of their application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby recommends to the Tribal Health Authority that it provide Mr. Kino Kane, who has applied for a position in that department a courtesy letter regarding the status of his application and an apology for their failure to provide him the courtesy of a reply prior to his coming to the Tribal Council this date.

The foregoing resolution was on April 2, 1997 duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against and one abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribe Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
