## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal Member Etheline Cosen, a former employee at the Chagache Day Care Center, has come before the Tribal Council as a follow-up to a previous Council Resolution whereby the Tribal Council instructed the Day Care Director and Board of Directors to hold appropriate elections and to resolve personnel disputes at the Day Care Center; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Cosen advises the Tribal Council that she was terminated from her employment at the Day Care Center; and
- WHEREAS, after considerable discussion with the Tribal Council in respect to the procedures leading to Ms. Cosen's termination the Tribal Council concludes that the Tribal Chairman should be directed to submit a letter to the Day Care Director that it is the consensus of the Tribal Council that Ms. Etheline Cosen should be reinstated to her position at the Day Care Center and that other personnel disputes and procedures of the Board and the administration of the Day Care Center should be discussed among employees and personnel for the benefit of the children.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Chairman Ronnie Lupe to submit a letter to the Day Care Director for the reinstatement of Etheline Cosen.

The foregoing resolution was on May 14,1997, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
