RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council on May 16, 1997, in Resolution 05-97-124 appointed a Tribal Apprenticeship Committee (TAP), consisting of Cline Griggs, Brenda Gloshay, and Kenneth Westover; and
- WHEREAS, the Council finds that the above named individuals are knowledgeable in the goals of the TAP committee as well as the TERO program; and
- **WHEREAS,** many of the issues and responsibilities of the TAP also relate to and affect the TERO program; and
- WHEREAS, at present there is no TERO commission to provide for administrative review of TERO decisions, including sanctions and other disciplinary actions; and
- WHEREAS, the current TAP committee could ably serve as the TERO commission.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby establishes a TERO commission with responsibility to provide review of disciplinary or sanction actions taken by the TERO, settle any grievances arising between the TERO staff and Director, and approve/disapprove the development of TERO policies, compliance plans and penalty schedules.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Cline Griggs, Brenda Gloshay and Kenneth Westover to serve on the TERO commission for an indefinite term.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 11, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
