RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council on May 16, 1997 in Resolution 05-97-124 appointed a Tribal Apprenticeship Committee; and
- WHEREAS, such committee is responsible for establishing policies and approving programs for the Tribal Apprenticeship Program; and
- WHEREAS, in addition to a committee, appointment of a program director is necessary to attend to the day to day matters of the Tribal Apprenticeship Program; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Apprenticeship Program is closely interrelated with the TERO program.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints the Director of the TERO Program to also serve as Director of the Tribal Apprenticeship Program.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 11, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
