## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Theodore Roosevelt School (TRS) Broad currently has two (2) vacancies; and
- WHEREAS, the TRS Board needs full membership to achieve maximum results and to assure that accountability is in place; and
- WHEREAS, the responsibility for appointments to the TRS Board resides with the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, many children from the Cibecue community attend TRS, and the Tribal Council recognizes that a representative from that community is needed on the TRS Board; and
- WHEREAS, Paulette Altaha is a member of the Cibecue community who speaks fluent Apache and will bring to the Board a representative for the children of Cibecue; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has a numerous occasions expressed its interest in insuring that TRS helps promote and teach our children Apache Culture; and
- WHEREAS, Ramon Riley has distinguished himself in a number of ways in service to the Tribe as the Tribe's Cultural Resource Director who has a deep and abiding interest in, and knowledge of, Apache Culture; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2-97-027 the Tribal Council resolved that appointment to the TRS Board shall be for a four (4) year fixed term, and shall be eligible for reappointment
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Pauletta Altaha and Ramon Riley be appointed to the Theodore Roosevelt School Board for a four (4) year term ending on June 30, 2001.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 13, 1997</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
